Dr Erwin Groeneveld is a highly skilled Vitreous and Retina Surgeon with 15 years experience as a senior visiting consultant at the Princess Alexandra Hospital in Brisbane. He established and supervised the Advanced Trainee Fellowship Post in Retinal Surgery whilst he was chairman of the eye department.

Born in Sydney and educated in Queensland, he attended the University of Queensland Medical School where he received the Anatomical Dissection Prize. He gained experience in complex Diabetic Vitrectomy Surgery whilst a fellow at the Melbourne University Retinal Investigation Unit.

Dr Groeneveld adopted the use anti-VEGF therapy for eye disease in Queensland and introduced intravitreal injection treatment for Macular Degeneration to the public hospital system. He has a special interest in diabetic eye disease.

He has served as an officer in the Australian Army Reserve, as an AusAID surgeon in the Pacific and on the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Ophthalmologists' State Executive as Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and Member of College Council. He is the immediate past Medical Director of the Vision Eye Institute at River City, and he serves as a Member of the Peninsula Private Hospital Medical Advisory Committee.

He holds a position as Consultant Ophthalmologist to the Indigenous Diabetic Eye Service in Central Queensland. He has a keen interest both in patient safety during surgical procedures and macula surgery.

Dr Fiona Chan graduated from The University of Queensland in 1997 with first class Honours and commenced her residency training at the Princess Alexandra Hospital in Brisbane. She commenced Ophthalmology training as a registrar in 2003 in Queensland and was appointed to the role of Senior Registrar in 2007 in her final year of training.

Dr Chan has been a Consultant Ophthalmologist at the Brisbane Eye Clinic since late 2008, which is located in the Brisbane CBD and Aspley. She practices General Adult Ophthalmology and focuses her practice on the management of Cataract cases.

Her surgeries are performed at the Vision Eye Institute, Auchenflower, Eyetech Day Surgeries, Mt Gravatt and Peninsula Private Hospital, Redcliffe.

Dr Chan is a fellow of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Ophthalmologists. She is involved in regular training of GP registrars with ophthalmology workshops for the Metro North Sunshine Coast Division of General Practice Training Queensland and provides lectures to local optometrists and General Practitioners.

CLINICAL OPTOMETRY SERVICE

Our therapeutically qualified clinical optometrists are available to assess anterior and posterior eye conditions and to confer, assess, treat or refer - depending on the nature of the clinical eye condition. This timely approach is backed by our Ophthalmologists and where necessary appropriate referral can be streamlined.

Clinical assessments with full access to BEC practice equipment include:

- Red and painful eye
- Sudden changes in vision (drop in vision, floaters/flashes)
- Diabetic assessment (annual check up)
- Eye strain, new or sudden headaches
- Glaucoma assessment

The service offers an easily accessible low cost alternative to that of the public hospital clinics.

POSTERIOR SEGMENT SERVICES

In addition to providing safe, precise, cost effective Cataract Surgery and Emergency Eye Care, the Brisbane Eye Clinic has a very strong reputation for the provision of expert surgical care to correct retinal detachment, epiretinal membrane, macula hole, diabetic eye disease and age related macula degeneration.

Our ability to manage these complex conditions in patients with significant co-morbidities within the one practice entity allows patients to receive timely, effective, integrated and stream lined eye care.

EMERGENCY EYE CARE

A Consultant Ophthalmologist is On Call 7 days per week for emergency eye care relating to sudden vision loss and retinal tear or detachment.

Referring Optometrists should contact our main line 07 3832 1700 to access our Ophthalmologist after hours. If no response, please leave a message and the doctor will respond promptly.

To access Medicare and Health Fund rebates, all emergency eye care patients require a current referral from an Optometrist, Ophthalmologist or Hospital Emergency Department.


