

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS FOLLOWING INTRAVITREAL INJECTION**

### **DR WENG NG**

Please note that following an intravitreal injection, you may experience some grittiness or foreign body sensation in the first 24 hours.

You may take oral Paracetamol (Panadol) as necessary.

You may remove your eye pad (if you have one) after two (2) hours.

If your eye feels gritty, you may use lubricating eye drops as required in the first two (2) days.

It is not unusual to have a blood shot eye, this may take up to ten (10) days to gradually disappear.

Occasionally you will see bubbles or “blobs” in your vision, this should disappear over two (2) days.

It is not usual for the vision to be slightly more blurry than usual in the first 24 hours.
