If you are attending any of our clinics and/ or day surgeries, please ensure:

- You are well and do not have a temperature, cough or cold
- Utilise the alcohol-based hand rub available at reception to clean your hands thoroughly
- Cover any coughs or sneezes and dispose of any tissues appropriately.

Anyone suffering from a respiratory illness, or returning from overseas travel, should not attend Brisbane Eye Clinic for at least two weeks.

At Brisbane Eye Clinic, our team continues to diagnose and treat complex and urgent eye diseases and conditions with our clinic and surgery units operating as per normal.

We expect parking to become more accessible at both locations and encourage patients, together with their carers, to travel by private vehicle where possible.
